



## PRIVACY POLICY

On November 13, 2000, the United States Securities and Exchange Commission adopted Regulation S-P, Privacy of Consumer Financial Information. This notice is delivered to you to comply with this regulation.

As you know, Stewardship Financial Advisors, LLC. (SFA) collects and has access to nonpublic personal information about each of our clients. This information includes, but is not limited to, balance sheet, income statement and other personal data such as social security numbers of clients and family and information concerning disposition of client estates. SFA, as a service to its' clients, has disclosed at one time or another all types of this data to the clients' other personal advisors, such as attorneys and accountants. SFA has never and will never disclose any of this data to parties other than other client advisors. In addition, SFA discloses data to the various custodians that actually hold client assets for the purpose of managing client accounts.

Each client of SFA may opt out of this disclosure to other advisors by simply contacting our office and asking us to not discuss any of the above information with any of your other advisors. SFA has policies and procedures in place to protect the confidentiality and security of client records and information. These policies and procedures include administrative, technical and physical safeguards. These policies and procedures include, but are not limited to, employee education, computer security through password granted access and physical security through limited access to SFA office facilities. A complete explanation of these safeguards is available to any client who requests them.
